



## JANUARY SPEAKER

Our January 9th Speaker will be FRED CLARKE of Sunset Valley Orchids, of Vista, CA.

Fred's topic will be "Today's Mini & Compact Cattleya's - A detailed look at the species & latest developments in the breeding & growing of these colorful flowers"

Fred started Sunset Valley Orchids in 1995 as a natural outgrowth of a hobby that began 25 years earlier. His "Boutique" style nursery has grown considerably over the last few years and now exceeds 30,000 sq. ft. of greenhouse space. Sunset Valley Orchids breeds orchids of award quality focusing their efforts on the development of new and interesting lines. All their plant offerings are produced in their own laboratory and are grown from seed at the nursery.

Fred is an accredited American Orchid Society Judge and Sunset Valley Orchids has received hundreds of AOS awards including 8 that have received the highest honor, the First Class Certificate including Fredclarkeara After Dark 'SVO Black Night' FCC/AOS (see orchid in photo of Fred)

Buy quality plants that welcome wildlife, consider plant size when you make your purchase, and aim for a diversity of trees, shrubs, groundcovers, and flowers. Once these plants are established, they'll require little—if any—supplemental water, fertilizer, or pesticides, saving you time and money.
